Terms of Payment

The parent/quardian agrees to pay \$400 for this course with these terms:

- -Full payment must be received prior to the first day of class.
- -Additional in vehicle instruction, if necessary, will be \$60 per hour.
- -Please note students must provide at least a 24 hour notification prior to their scheduled driving time if they need to reschedule. If they fail to do so there will be a \$25 fee for each incident.

Conditions of Segment 1 Drivers Training Instruction

-The student must be at least 14 years and 8 months of age and they must provide a copy of their birth certificate as evidence. The parent/quardian certifies that the student does not have any physical limitations which could interfere with the student's driving ability. Polyservice Driving School will provide a minimum of 24 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel (BTW) instruction, including 4 hours of observation time in a dual controlled vehicle, fully insured, covering each student enrolled in the program. Classroom instruction must be a minimum of three weeks in length. BTW instruction shall not begin until the student has completed a minimum of 4 hours of classroom instruction. BTW must be completed by no later than 3 week after the final day of classroom instruction. The course will be held for 3 weeks: Monday through Thursday, from 10am to 12pm 3:30pm to 6pm to 8pm at our location on 42929 Van Dyke, Sterling Heights. Books and other supplies will be provided by the driving school. Books must be maintained in the same condition as the student may be fined for damages to their book. In order for the student to obtain his/her certificate they must pass all lecture requirements, the in-car evaluation, and the state standardized test. The minimum passing score the student must score on the standardized final exam is 70%.

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Refund Policy

- a) 100% refund on the first day of class
- b) 80% refund on the second day of class
- c) No cash refunds are available past the third day of class but the student may join another Segment 1 class within 6 months to complete the course if necessary
- d) Instructors may at any time refuse to provide instruction if the student is suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- e) Students caught vandalizing property or fighting will immediately be expelled with no refund as safety is our highest priority
